## Laying the Foundation for LCRT Construction

Lowcountry Rapid Transit (LCRT) is gearing up for construction. Our project team has begun construction preparations and will continue this work over the next year as the project moves closer to this significant milestone.


Soon, we'll start engaging with contractors and other organizations who will construct LCRT. These organizations will build the system's 20 modern stations and roadway improvements, as well as implement new technologies, like transit signal priority. Early engagement with them will be paramount to an efficient construction process.

LCRT's Construction phase will be the final phase of the project under the Federal Transit Administration's Capital Investment Grants (CIG) Program.

LCRT is positioned to create **new employment opportunities** in the Lowcountry through the system's construction. We'll share more information about LCRT's employment opportunities and economic benefits in the coming months.
